






South African Sign Language (SASL)

Nguni languages

Nguni languages are part of the bigger Bantu language family.
Nguni languages include Xhosa,
Zulu, Ndebele, and Swati. These languages are special because of their clicks. These clicks were introduced a very long time ago due to contact with Khoisan language speakers. Languages change due to contact between people!

Languages are fluid

Languages are more like a liquid than a solid. They change all the time when speakers are in conact with each other. People switch between languages for different purposes and mix their languages. This is all a normal part of human life!
